RENEW OR REPLACE DRIVERS LICENSE OR ID WHILE OUT OF PROVINCE

The following is the process to **renew or replace** your driver's license or ID card remotely while you are outside of Alberta or medically homebound:

- 1) Attached is a form named "Remote Driver's License/ID Card Application" or you may click this link https://formsmgmt.gov.ab.ca/Public/REG11197.xdp
- 2) Email the following documents to <u>motorvehicles@newurbanregistry.com</u>
 - The completed Remote Driver's License/ID Card Application form (signed, and initialed)
 INITIALS IN PART D, NOT CHECKMARKS OR X'S
 - Proof of your Alberta address dated within the last 90 days
 - A copy of your valid government issued photo ID If you do not have valid photo ID you must send another piece of government ID (Alberta Health Care, Passport etc...)
 - A letter from a general practitioner, nurse practitioner, or care facility stating that if medically homebound or in long-term care
 - A completed Medical Examination for Motor Vehicle Operators form if renewing a commercial driver's license
- 3) Once the documents are accepted and approved, you would make the payment for the service via the link at the bottom of your invoice email (<u>Click here to review and pay this invoice</u>)
- 4) Once payment is completed we will process your service. Your license may only be renewed for a 1 year term *. Your ID card may be renewed for the full term.
 - *Medically homebound clients may renew licenses for the full term
- 5) Once the service is processed we mail email the temporary license or ID card to you via **encrypted email.**
- 6) Your new permanent license or ID card will be mailed by the Alberta government to your address in 1-2 weeks. This license or ID card will contain a code "F" and will need to be removed the next time an operator service is completed. When you come into the office for your next service and to remove the code F you will need the following documents:
 - Your legal entitlement to be in Canada (Canadian birth certificate, Canadian passport, Canadian citizenship, or immigration documents)
 - Your valid photo ID (license)
 - Proof of your Alberta address dated within the last 90 days
