

## Consent for Minor

You must accompany the minor on their first visit to the registry with the form for it to be valid, the registry agent must witness the signature of the parent/ guardian.

If the parent/guardian is out of province the form must be stamped by a Notary and not a Commissioner of Oaths, the registry will only be able to accept the original notarized form.

In accordance with the *Traffic Safety Act (TSA)*, *Operator Licensing and Vehicle Control Regulation*, and the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (s.33)* for motor vehicle services, the Registrar of Motor Vehicles collects personal information for the following purposes: to confirm identity and eligibility of an individual for motor vehicle services and for motor vehicle records held by Motor Vehicles; investigation and enforcement; and for contact information, including the residential address in order for the personal serving of documents under the TSA.
